**SUBJECT:** Basin Advisory Committee Membership

At the September-October 2009 Basin Advisory Committee (BAC) meetings, the BACs made the following committee recommendations to the Kansas Water Authority (KWA):

- The Missouri BAC recommends the appointment of Tom Olson for the basin At-Large category for the term expiring in 2013.
- The Neosho BAC recommends the appointment of Steve Kubler for the Municipal category for the term expiring in 2013.

Note: Steve Kubler officially resigned his previous At-Large category position on July 29, 2009 to make him eligible to apply for the Municipal category that became vacant as of July 1, 2009.

On October 26, 2009, the KWA BAC Membership Committee reviewed the applications and recommendations of the BACs. The KWA BAC Membership Committee recommended that the KWA accept the BAC recommendations for membership as proposed.

With the approval of these two nominees, there are ten vacant BAC positions statewide. These include the Missouri (commerce and industry, fish and wildlife, and municipal), Neosho (at-large/public, recreation), Kansas-Lower Republican (other public water supply), Smoky Hill-Saline (fish and wildlife), Upper Arkansas (commerce and industry, at-large/public), and Upper Republican (agriculture). These vacant BAC positions will be accepting applications through February 12, 2010 for consideration at the February-March BAC meetings.

Nomination recommendations made by the BACs will be reviewed by KWA in May.
